- The original battery included is a test battery. If the battery runs out, please replace the battery by referring to the battery replacement method. (Button Battery - CR2032)

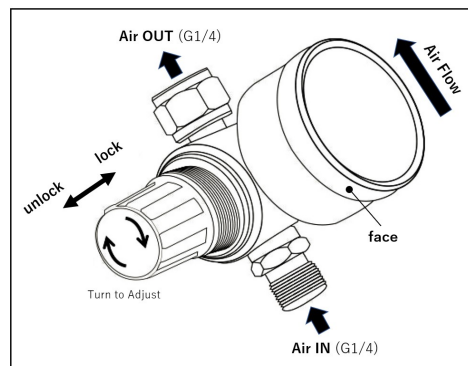
## Installation

1. Disconnect the compressed air supply.
2. Install regulator outlet connector onto the spray gun.
3. Connect the regulator inlet to an air hose connector.
4. Turn on air supply.
5. To adjust the air regulator pressure.
  - Pull the knob and turn.

**Clockwise ⇒ increase(+)pressure**

**Counterclockwise ⇒ decrease(-)pressure**

6. Push the knob down to lock the air pressure setting



## Operation Instruction

- It may be damaged or deformed if the product is dropped or impacted.
- This is an auto ON/OFF air adjusting pressure gauge. If the gauge detects a change of pressure above 0.02MPa, the gauge will automatically turn on. The pressure gauge will remain on for the full duration of the spray gun use. The gauge will turn off once air pressure is below 0.02MPa.



**When not in use, please be sure to turn the knob to set the display pressure of the regulator to 0 and stop the supply of compressed air to the regulator. If compressed air is supplied, the power will remain ON and may lead to loss of battery.**

## Handling

- When attaching to a spray gun, tighten with a tool.

## Battery Replacement

1. Turn the "face" counter wise (See Figure 1.2)
2. Use a small tool to push battery out as shown on the circuit board (See Figure 2)
3. Insert a new **CR2032** battery with (-) facing upwards.
4. When a new battery is installed correctly, the power goes on after 5 seconds and then automatically go to rest process.
5. Push and turn the face of the gauge clock wise. When tightening, face of the gauge must be horizontal.

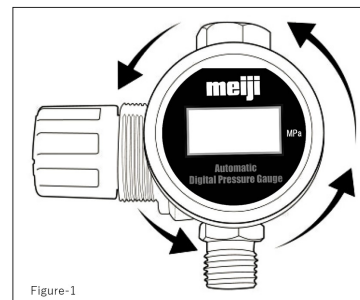

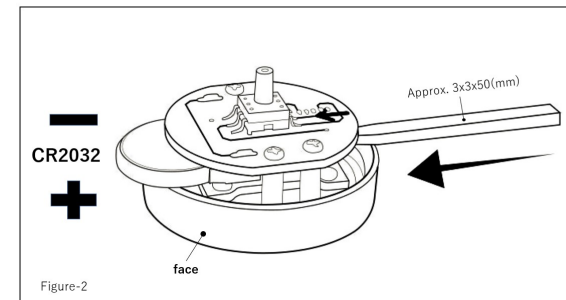

- Remove and reinsert the battery will reset the gauge to zero.
